So they 8 haven't approached -- but they haven't approached 9 this -- this board on that, they approached the 10 11 supervisors on that. MS. LAMBERTON: I didn't think 12 13 they need to approach us. MR. ARMSTRONG: No, if it --14 No, 'cause this MS. BISBING: 15 is just relative to the special assessment that 16 they would have to pay if there isn't enough TIF 17 revenue to pay the bonds. 18 Yeah, yep. MR. MOYER: 19 Well, that's --MR. ARMSTRONG: 20 that's one -- I mean, you --21 MS. BISBING: Then the money 22 23 will go --MR. ARMSTRONG: You're a NID 24 Authority. You're a NIDMA Authority right now, so 25

granted, the way it was set up, the only thing 1 really before you is the potential special 2 assessment in the event the TIF bond doesn't cover 3 However, you know, under the act, if this 4 it. board were to consider additional public 5 improvements within the NID District, that would be 6 something that would be appropriate to be before 7 the board. But it sounds like this specific item 8 is outside of the NID District --9 MR. HOLAHAN: Okay. 10 -- that was MR. ARMSTRONG: 11 created by Tobyhanna Township. There's a number of 12 things that a NIDMA can, you know, be involved in. 13 It's just this one specific item that we knew that 14 was going to be before you on a regular basis, is 15 the special assessment associated with the Kalahari 16 17 TIF. Is it just easier 18 MR. MOYER: for the township to require the permits and stuff 19 20 needed for that? MS. LAMBERTON: For the 21 22 funding. MR. MOYER: Oh, for the 23 24 funding. MR. HOLAHAN: So it wasn't 25
